

LITTER POLICY

It is the responsibility of every member of the school community to ensure that the environment is respected and that this policy concerning the environment is followed. Litter should be placed in the litter bins provided in each classroom and around the school.

Students

Food may be brought into school or can be purchased from the restaurant or deli bar. Hot food from the restaurant must be eaten there. Only the Sixth Form may take it away. Food from home may be eaten in the form room for Year 9 upwards. The Small Hall is available until 1.40 pm for Years 7 and 8 to eat their packed lunch.

All litter must be placed in the litter bins provided or taken home.

Each tutor group is responsible for ensuring that their tutor room is tidy and litter free. Any tutor group which does not ensure this may find that their form room is locked at lunch time.

Students may not:

- take hot food away from the restaurant,
- eat or drink in the corridors,
- eat or drink, other than water, during a lesson or during registration,
- drop litter anywhere except in the bins provided,
- bring chewing gum into school

Any student who abuses the school environment will be sanctioned.

Staff

Staff on lunch duty in the restaurant must ensure that hot food is not taken away. Staff on duty in the small hall should ensure that the litter bins provided are used.

Staff have a responsibility to ensure that pupils respect the school environment and adhere to the expectations set out for pupils above.

Staff should also ensure that they check that their form room is free from litter at the end of registration and that their teaching room is tidy at the beginning and end of each lesson.

In this way the school environment will be respected and will be more pleasant for every member of the school community.
